Our services usually last about an hour and a half. We sing songs to **encounter God** and **give Him praise**, we **read the Bible** to hear God speak to us, we **pray together** to see God do the impossible and **break bread** with one another.

St. Peter's Kids and Youth is for children **aged 2 - 10 (Kids)** and **11 - 15 (Youth)**. Kids under 2 are welcome to stay with their parents in the main service but there is a **crèche room** available for you to use (kids in the crèche must be supervised by their parents at all times.)

Look out for **Kids Church helpers** and **Youth Team helpers** with **bright lanyards** to help direct you and your child to the right place. You are welcome to stay in kids church with your children for the first couple of weeks to help them settle in.

Circles are a **tool to help you grow in faith** and live this out everyday, as you meet regularly with 2-3 others.

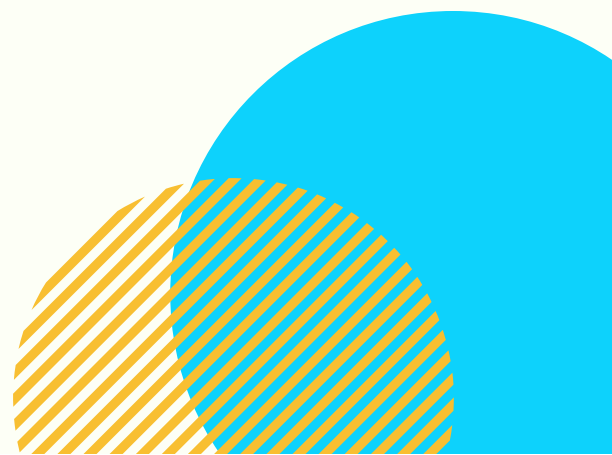
